Lynn Cancer Institute is revolutionizing the treatment of cancer and patient care, utilizing the latest technological advancements and the most sophisticated diagnostic services and treatments available. The award-winning, \$73 million, 98,000-square-foot facility houses Boca Raton Regional Hospital's imaging, radiation, chemotherapy, genetics and cancer support services, as well as its clinical research capabilities. The Institute holds one of the largest cancer programs (by patient volume) in Florida and is accredited as a Comprehensive Cancer Center by the Commission on Cancer, a program of the American College of Surgeons.

More than 20 oncology physicians and a full complement of oncology professionals are on staff to serve the patients at the Institute. Our patients receive treatment and services from internationally renowned physicians with specialized expertise in breast, urologic, head and neck, thoracic, gastrointestinal, hepatobiliary and bloodborne cancers. In addition, our staff includes oncology-trained registered nurses, research nurses, licensed clinical social workers and registered dietitians.
